

Austin Med Spa & Aesthetics Market Analysis

Executive Summary

Austin's medical aesthetics market is experiencing explosive growth, mirroring national trends that project the U.S. med spa industry to reach **\$18.02 billion by 2032** (14.3% CAGR). Texas ranks among the top states with **820+ med spas**, and Austin—as one of the fastest-growing metro areas—sits at the epicenter of intense local competition.

Key Market Dynamics:

- **14-15% annual growth** projected through 2026
- Heavy M&A activity with private equity targeting fragmented single-owner spas
- Tech-savvy demographics (millennials/Gen Z) driving non-invasive treatment demand

1. Audit Your Online Reputation

- o Check Google, Yelp, RealSelf, Facebook ratings TODAY
- o Respond to every review (positive and negative) within 24 hours
- o Implement automated review request system post-appointment
- o **Goal:** Reach 200+ Google reviews within 6 months (competitive moat)

2. Price Shop Every Competitor

- o Mystery shop all 9 major competitors for your core services
- o Document pricing, upsell tactics, experience quality
- o Adjust pricing strategy based on competitive position
- o **Decision:** Premium (Beaux), value (Texas Laser), or mid-tier positioning?

3. Verify Your Digital Presence

- o Can patients book online 24/7? If no, implement immediately.
- o Is pricing visible on your website? (Transparency wins trust)
- o Does your Google Business Profile have updated hours, photos, services?
- o **Goal:** Remove all booking friction

4. Analyze February Promotions

- o What are competitors offering THIS MONTH?
- o Are you leaving money on the table with weak promotions?
- o Create Valentine's/seasonal offer competitive with market
- o **Urgency:** Promotional calendar = revenue predictability

90-Day Initiatives

1. Launch or Optimize GLP-1 Weight Loss Program

- o Partner with telemedicine provider or hire prescriber
- o Price at \$150-250/month (competitive with market)
- o Market as "medical weight loss" not just injections
- o **Revenue Potential:** 20 patients = \$3,000-5,000/month recurring

2. Implement Membership Model (if not already)

- o 3-tier structure: Basic (\$60-99), Premium (\$150-199), VIP (\$225-299)
- o Include monthly injectables/facials + discounts on other services
- o **Key Metric:** 50 members at \$150/mo = \$7,500 monthly recurring revenue

3. Content Marketing Campaign
